

# Supply Crate

## ***EFFECTIVE JAN 2015***



When you bring supplies to Belize we ask you to bring them in a specific crate. There are several reasons for this:

- They are sturdy and survive plane journeys
- They fit within the maximum dimensions of standard (not oversize) aircraft luggage (just!)
- They can be cable tied shut
- We re-use them extensively in Belize and as everyone brings the same crate they stack cleanly empty or full! ☺



## **The tote is a Centrex Plastics/HDX 27-Gallon Tote.**

If you are packing the crate yourself:

- Pack the crate with no more than 50lbs of supplies.
- Print the shipping label on the next page, fill in your name, address and US phone number.
- Cut the label in half. Tape one half to the lid, the other half to the crate.
- Cable tie the lid shut on 2 opposite corners
- Use duct tape to secure 2 spare cable ties to the top of the crate. The TSA will use the spare ties to reseal the crate once they have searched it.
